Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How long will it take to build my WetDek?

A: Build times will vary, but a typical installation takes approximately one week.

Q: What types of surface material can I use?

A: The following materials are being used to design WetDek play pads or landscape features:

- Brushed & Sealed Concrete
- Stamped & Sealed Concrete
- Pool Decking
- Pebble-Flex
- Pavers
- River Rock (Waterless Pond Application)

Q: What design or shape options do I have?

A: Designs are only limited by your imagination! The most commonly used shapes are: circle, square, rectangle, kidney or freeform.

Q: Do I need to winterize my WetDek?

A: You should winterize the unit if you are expecting freezing temperatures. Winterizing is very easy and should only take about 30 minutes to complete. Please see our installation manual for complete details.

Q: How do I keep the water clean?

A: Each stand-alone kit comes with a filter and chlorinator. Proper use of these units will keep the water sanitary and clean. Test your WetDek water regularly with accurate test kits or test strips. You can find these at your local pool and spa dealer.

Q: Do I need to change out the water?

A: The stand alone WetDek is programmed to recirculate the water every 12 to 24 hours so you shouldn't need to change it, however, it is good practice to test the water weekly (check with your pool and spa professional for a recommendation specific to your region). If you do need to change the water, follow instructions for draining the reservoir, then re-fill per instructions.

Q: Can I use the WetDek to spray into my pool?

A: Absolutely! The WetDek is an interactive water feature that can be used in many ways.

Q: Does the WetDek have a suction drain?

A: No... the WetDek has a gravity drain system which allows gravity to gently pull the water down the drain.
